#### 1. Area of Planned Activity

Current monitoring devices will be deployed in the vicinity of S11 Wind Turbine Generator Suction Caisson Foundation Jacket structure within the Seagreen Offshore Windfarm. The coordinates and location of S11 are shown below in table 1 and fig 1

## 2. Activity Description.

Mariners are advised that three current monitoring devices will be deployed on the seabed within one metre of the S11 wind turbine generator suction caisson foundation jacket structure legs.

The multi-purpose Offshore Vessel Siem Dorado will utilise a remotely operated vehicle to deploy the devices on the seabed. The date of these works will be provided in an update to this notice.

The devices will be removed from the seabed at a date to be confirmed.

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## 4. General Safety Advice

Due to the vessels mode of operation and equipment used, the vessel will at time be Restricted in her ability to manoeuvre.

The vessel will exhibit appropriate lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, relative to their operations. The vessel will also transmit an Automatic Identification System (AIS) message.

### 4.1 Safety Zones

Following consideration by Scottish Government Ministers it has been agreed that during the construction phases of the Seagreen development, mandatory rolling 500m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations whilst construction works are in progress, as indicated by the presence of a construction vessel. The safety zones will be triggered whenever a vessel is on station at a WTG and undertaking construction activities.

In addition, mandatory pre commissioning 50m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations when construction works have been completed but prior to Wind Farm commissioning or where construction works have only been partially completed. These safety zones will be active at any structure during the construction phase where a construction vessel is not present at a Wind Turbine Generator.

**ALL VESSELS ARE REQUESTED** to give the vessel at least 500m safety clearance

**MARINERS ARE REMINDED** to navigate with caution and keep continuous watch on VHF Ch 70/16 when navigating the area.
