Seagreen Wind Energy Ltd. will conduct main component exchanges within the Seagreen offshore windfarm site boundary

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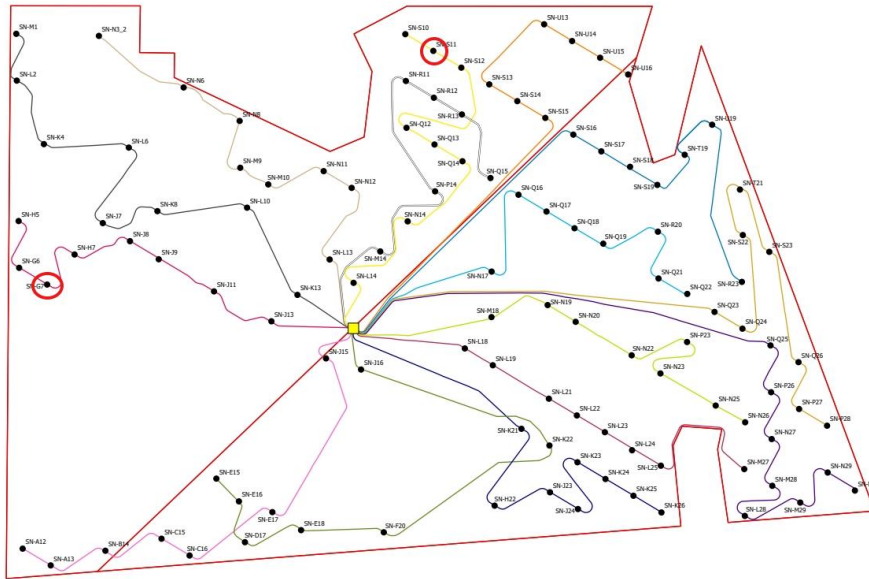


Fig 1 – Survey locations

2. Activity Description

The Jack Up vessel Apollo will conduct Main Component Exchanges at locations S11 followed by G07.


Apollo will be supported by CTV operations provided by MO6 who will be working 24 hours, operating between Montrose and Seagreen Offshore Windfarm.


Operations will take place subject to weather and other operational factors from 5th May until 31st May

The only means of direct VHF communications with the vessel is on VHF channel 16.

4. Safety Zones

Please be aware, 500m Safety Zones will be in place for this major maintenance campaign.

As all the Seagreen Wind Turbine Generators are fully commissioned, mandatory 500m safety zones shall be established around any WTG where major maintenance work is being undertaken, where major maintenance is as per the definition given in the 2007 Regulations. The safety zones will be active whenever a major maintenance vessel is at the WTG during the operational phase. Up to five of these safety zones could be concurrently active, but no more than four where there is one active 500m safety zone around the Offshore Sub-station Platform.

MARINERS ARE REMINDED to navigate with caution and keep continued watch on VHF Ch.70/16 when navigating the area.
