#### 1. Activity Description.

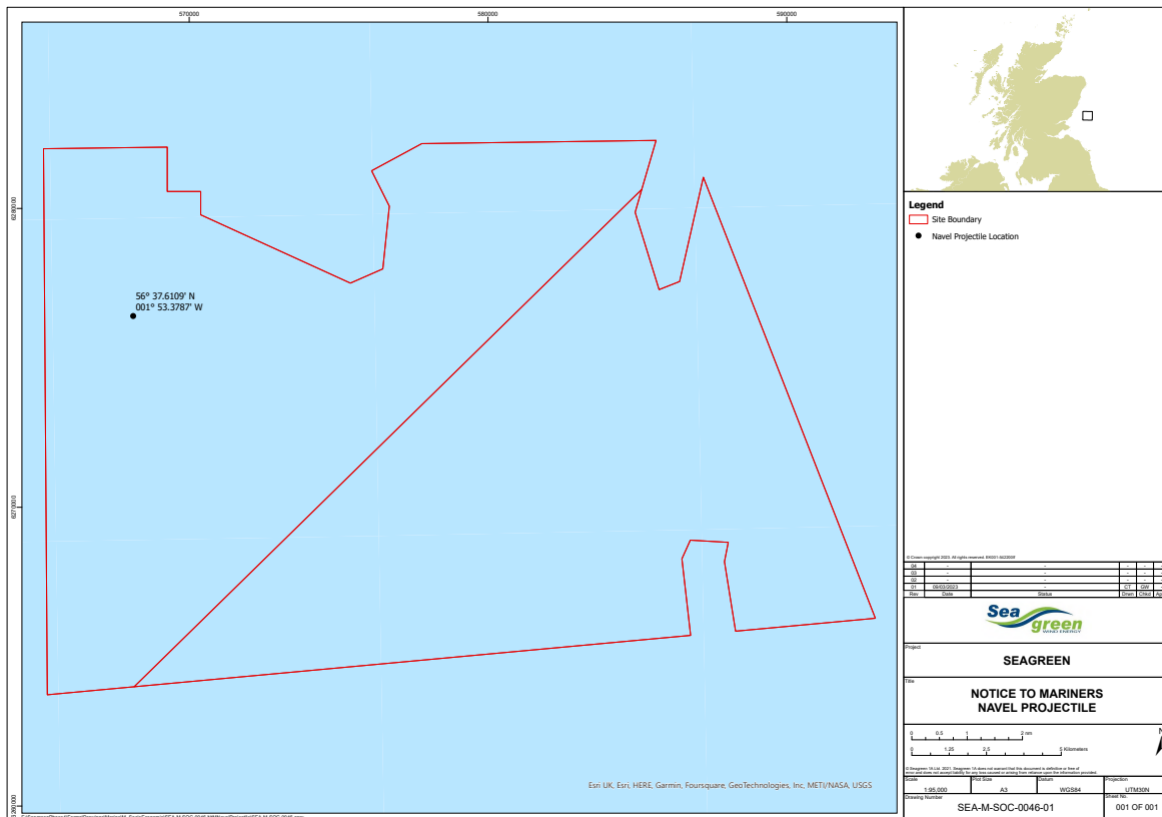


Fig 1 –UXO location.

A confirmed item of unexploded ordnance has been discovered during survey operations within the boundary of the Seagreen Offshore Wind Farm site. The object is believed to be a 12-16 inch naval projectile that could possibly contain high explosive. Coordinates and location of the object are shown below in table1 and fig 1.

The previously reported 500m safety zone has now been removed. Seagreen Wind Energy Ltd will retain a 50m avoidance zone for all subsea/seabed activity. No avoidance zone exists for surface navigation.

## 2. General Safety Advice

The previously reported 500m safety zone has been removed and vessel are free to navigate the area. Seagreen Wind Energy Ltd. Will retain a 50m avoidance zone for all subsea/seabed activity.

All vessels involved in the construction of the Seagreen development will exhibit appropriate lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea; relative to their operations. All vessels will also transmit an Automatic Identification System (AIS) message.

**MARINERS ARE REMINDED** to navigate with caution and keep continued watch on VHF Ch.70/16 when navigating the area.

## 3. Safety Zones

Following consideration by Scottish government ministers it has been agreed that during the construction phases of the Seagreen development mandatory rolling 500m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations whilst construction works are in progress, as indicated by the presence of a construction vessel. The safety zones will be triggered whenever a vessel is on station at a WTG and undertaking construction activities.

In addition, mandatory pre commissioning 50m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations when construction works have been completed but prior to Wind Farm commissioning or where construction works have only been partially completed. These

safety zones will be active at any structure during the construction phase where a construction vessel is not present at a Wind Turbine Generator.
