#### 1. Area of planned activity.

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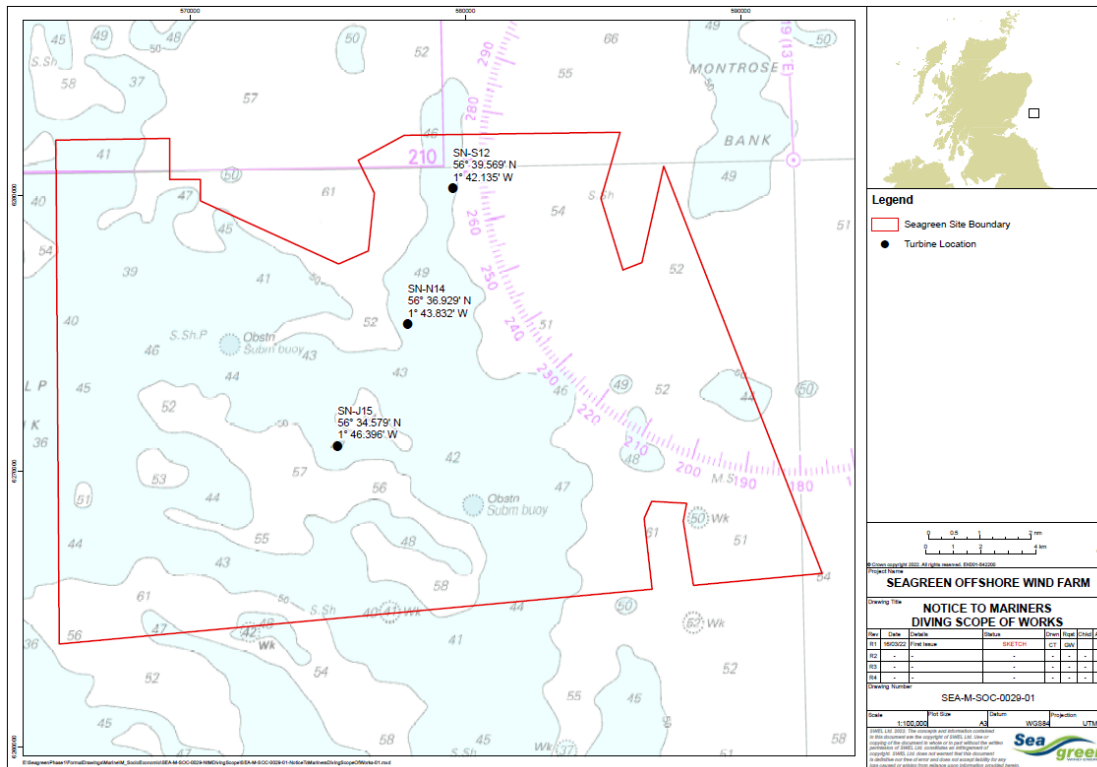


Fig 1 – WTG foundation locations

Diving operations will be carried out on three wind turbine generator foundation structures, Coordinates of the assets and locations are shown below in table 1 and fig 1.

## 2. Activity Description.

On behalf of Seagreen Wind Energy, Seaway 7 will conduct diving operations on three wind turbine generator foundation structures. Coordinates and locations for diving are shown above in table 1 and fig 1.

Operations will be conducted from the Dive Support Vessel Seven Kestrel, details of the vessel are shown below. Seven Kestrel will arrive at the Seagreen site on or around the 24<sup>th</sup> of March to commence operations.

During diving operations there shall be a strict 500m safety zone around the Seven Kestrel, all vessels are requested to give Seven Kestrel a wide berth at all times.

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## 4. General Safety Advice

All vessels involved in construction activities will exhibit appropriate lights and day-time shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, relative to operations. The vessel will also transmit an Automatic Identification System (AIS) message.

## 4. Safety Zones

Following consideration by Scottish government ministers it has been agreed that during the construction phases of the Seagreen development mandatory rolling 500m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations whilst construction works are in progress, as indicated by the presence of a construction vessel. The safety zones will be triggered whenever a vessel is on station at a WTG and undertaking construction activities.

In addition, mandatory pre commissioning 50m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations when construction works have been completed but prior to Wind Farm commissioning or where construction works have only been partially completed. These safety zones will be active at any structure during the construction phase where a construction vessel is not present at a Wind Turbine Generator.

**MARINERS ARE REMINDED** to navigate with caution and keep continued watch on VHF Ch.70/16 when navigating the area.
