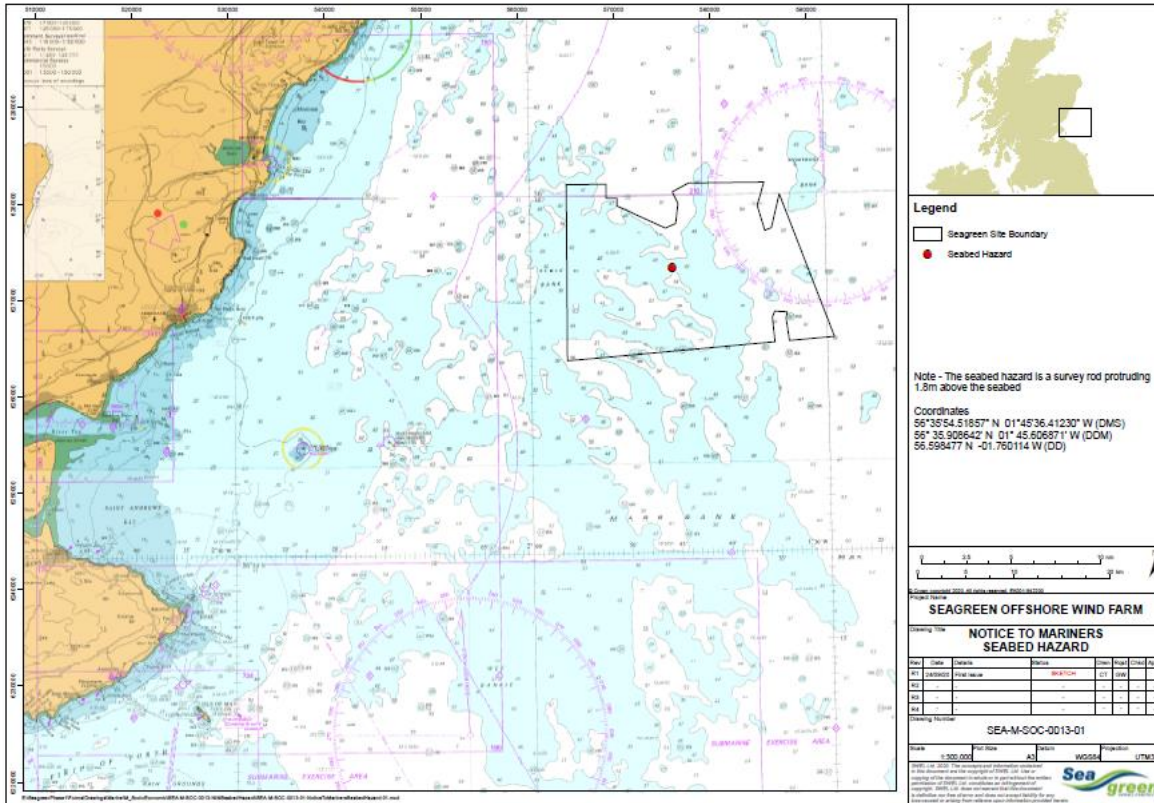

During survey operations, a 1.8m length of survey rod was left protruding from the seabed, Seagreen Notice to Mariners 05/2020 refers. This equipment will now be removed. The position is detailed in the table and chartlet below.
