1. Area of activity.

Rock placement activity will commence within the Seagreen export cable corridor.

2. Activity Description.

On behalf of Seagreen Wind Energy Ltd, Nexans AS will commence rock placement operations within the Seagreen export cable corridor.

The Flexible Fall Pipe Vessel, Rockpiper will install rock berms on exposed sections of all three Seagreen export cables. Three guard vessels are currently on location along the export cable guarding areas of exposed cable. The Rockpiper is expected to arrive within the cable corridor to commence operations on or around the 23rd of September. The export cable corridor is shown below

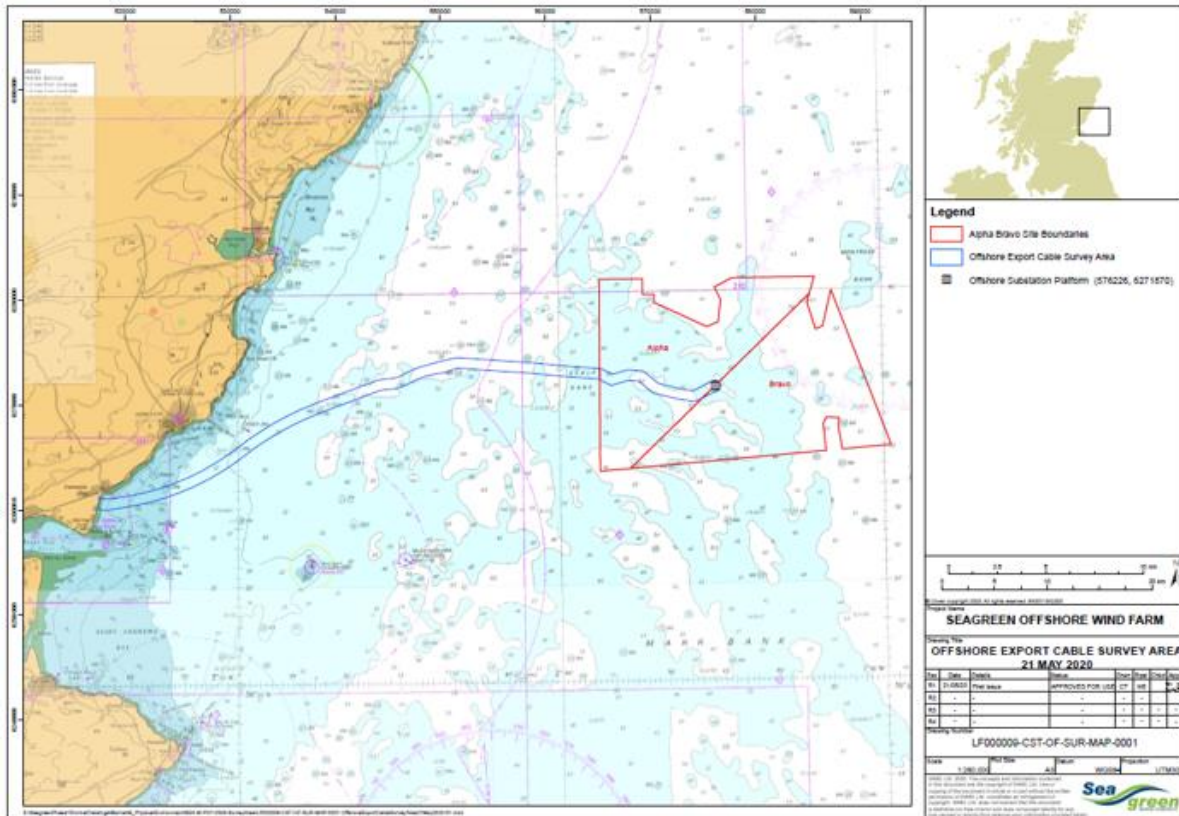



Fig 1 – Export cable corridor in blue.

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in fig 1, vessel details below in section 3. It is expected that Rockpiper will make a number of trips to the site over a period of weeks.

4. General Safety Advice

Mariners are reminded to navigate with caution and keep a continuous watch on VHF Ch 70/16 when navigating in and around the Seagreen area.

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All vessels involved in construction activities will exhibit appropriate lights and day-time shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, relative to operations. The vessel will also transmit an Automatic Identification System (AIS) message.

5. Safety Zones

Following consideration by Scottish government ministers it has been agreed that during the construction phases of the Seagreen development mandatory rolling 500m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations whilst construction works are in progress, as indicated by the presence of a construction vessel. The safety zones will be triggered whenever a vessel is on station at a WTG and undertaking construction activities.

In addition, mandatory pre commissioning 50m safety zones will be established around each Wind Turbine Generator and/or their foundations when construction works have been completed but prior to Wind Farm commissioning or where construction works have only been partially completed. These safety zones will be active at any structure during the construction phase where a construction vessel is not present at a Wind Turbine Generator.
