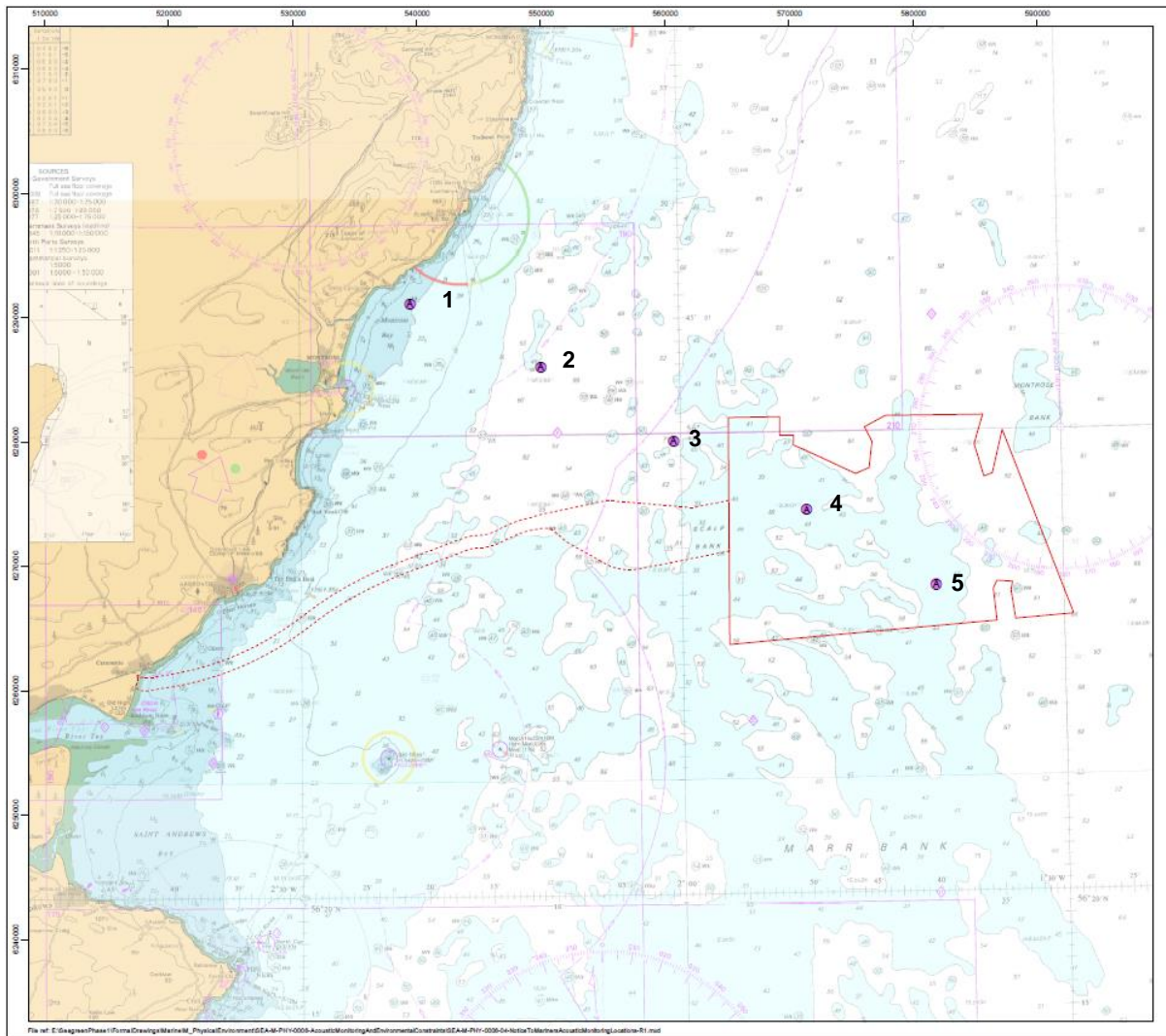


Fig 1 – Seagreen Offshore Windfarm Site Boundary and monitoring station locations

2. Activity Description.

Marine Scotland Science research vessel Alba na Mara will be servicing 2 acoustic monitoring devices within the Seagreen Offshore Windfarm site boundary. The locations of these devices are shown within the site boundary in Fig 1 by the numbers 4 & 5. Number 5 device will be relocated to the position shown below in Table 1.

The Alba na Mara is expected on site tomorrow, 17th of March, the works are expected to be completed on Thursday 18th of March.
