1. Area of Planned Activity.

Sheet pile and pile gate installation will take place at the Seagreen Offshore Windfarm export cable landfall site, the area of operations is located at the beach revetment, Carnoustie Golf Club, Angus. The area is shown below in Fig 1.

2. Activity Description.

On behalf of Seagreen Offshore Windfarm Ltd, Nexans AS require to install sheet piles to allow for the excavation of material followed by the installation of cable ducts, cement bound sand and final backfill. During the installation of the sheet piles Nexans require the use of a safety vessel to ensure that in the event of an emergency an individual can be immediately recovered from the water.

The safety vessel is expected to arrive on site on Monday the 1st of March. The works are expected to be concluded by the 31st of March however this period may be extended due to weather conditions.

There will be one safety vessel on site at any one time. The vessel will be chosen from the two below.

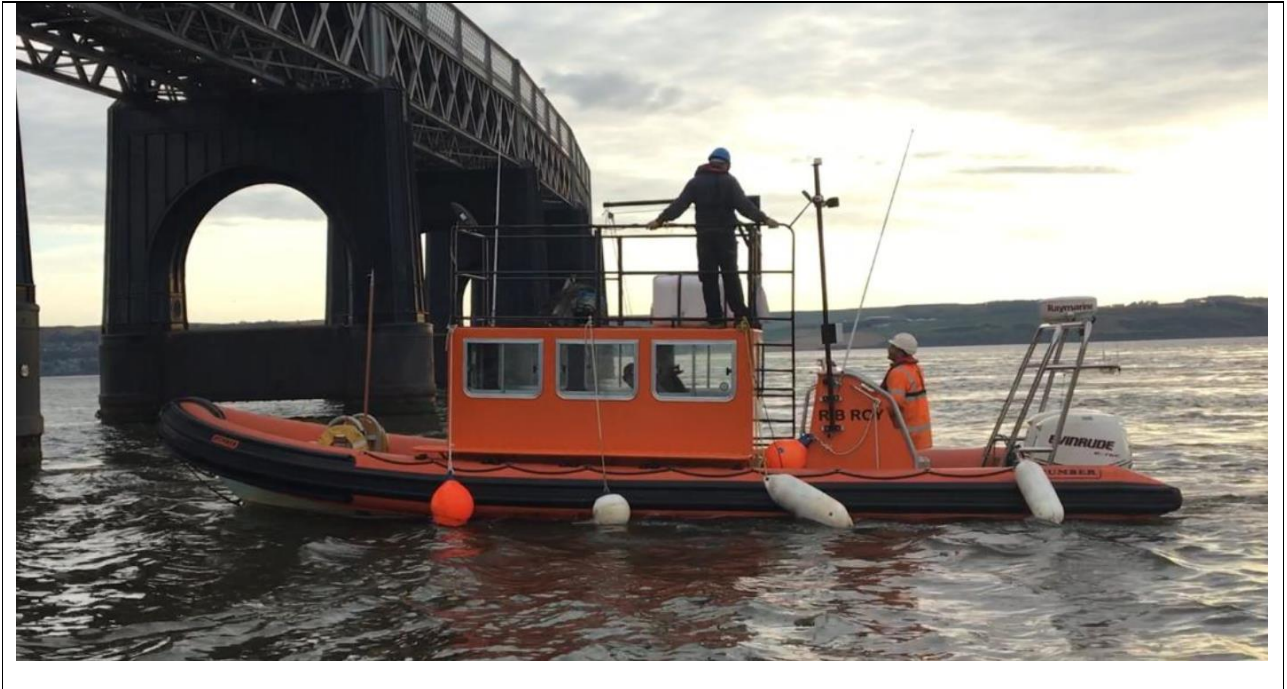
